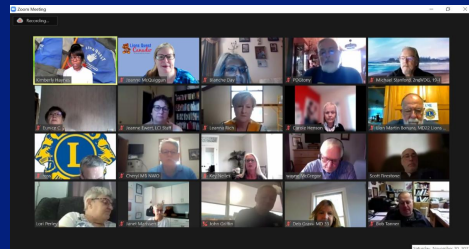
We thank Susan & Marvin for their time and dedication to advancing our mission to provide leadership, knowledge and resources to develop capable young Canadians of positive character.

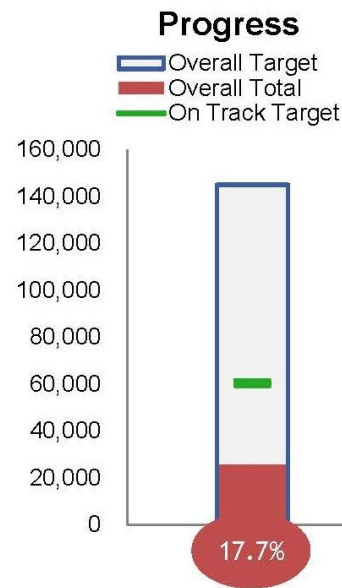
